

# How to Delete Your BoredomOver Account

If you want to permanently delete your BoredomOver account and all personal data we hold about you, follow the steps below.

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## ## Step 1 – Send a deletion request by email

Send an email to [contact@idiyed.com](mailto:contact@idiyed.com) with:

- **\*\*Subject:\*\*** `Delete my BoredomOver account`

- **\*\*Body:\*\*** include the email address you used to register in the BoredomOver app. That's the only thing we need to identify your account.

If you signed in with Google, use that same Google email.

> No special form, no phone calls, no paid service. One email is enough.

## ## Step 2 – We confirm and delete

Within **\*\*30 days\*\*** of receiving your request we will:

1. Reply to you confirming receipt.
2. Permanently delete your account and all personal data listed below.
3. Reply again confirming the deletion is complete.

## ## Step 3 – Remove the app (optional)

After the server data is deleted, uninstalling the BoredomOver app from your device will also clear any locally cached data (offline score queue, settings, etc.).

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## ## What Data Is Deleted

When your account is deleted we permanently remove:

- Your email address
- Your bcrypt-hashed password (we never had the plaintext)
- Your username
- Your country selection
- All game scores and timestamps you've ever submitted
- Your Google profile info (if you used Continue with Google)
- All active session tokens (you'll be signed out on every device)

## ## What Data Is Kept

We retain **no** identifying personal data after deletion. The only data that may remain is:

- Anonymous, aggregated usage counts (e.g., "BUTTONS had 12,400 plays last week") that contain no user identifiers.
- System backup snapshots that automatically expire within **30 days**. After that point nothing personal remains anywhere in our systems.
- Legal/compliance logs (e.g., abuse reports) where required by law – these are kept only as long as legally required and contain only the minimum data needed.

## ## Third-Party Data

- **Google AdMob** – ad-serving data (Advertising ID, ad interactions) is held by Google, not by us. You can reset or delete your Advertising ID at any time via **Android Settings → Google → Ads**.

- **Google Sign-In** – if you used it, revoke access via **<https://myaccount.google.com/permissions>** to remove our app from your Google account connections.
